

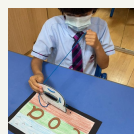

	Plan Do Review is put in place
	We offer screeners for children to help identify their barrier to learning. This allows us to plan the steps to support learning at Royal Dubai School. Children are monitored by their class teachers. Sometimes, children can be identified on entry.
	Meetings are held with parents to discuss needs
	Children are placed on our SEND register and an IEP (Individual Education Plan) is created to identify specific targets
	IEP targets are monitored and the support in place is reviewed termly

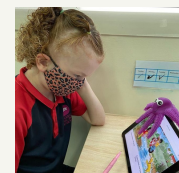
Inclusion

If you are concerned about your child's academic, social or emotional development we can arrange an observation or assessment to gain further information. Then we can discuss strategies to help your child at home and school. This may involve in school, external agencies or our school counsellor.

We have a range of programmes to support across all four areas of need. These are Cognition and Learning, Communication and Interaction, Social, Emotional and Mental Health and Physical, Sensory and Medical.

You are welcome to attend the ACe events held throughout the year. If your child is on Level 2 or 3, you will be invited to termly meetings.



ELL

At RDS, the English Language Learning programme caters for children from Foundation Stage 1 to Year 6 whose first language is other than English. The purpose of our ELL programme is to help children acquire a proficient level of English so they can access the curriculum with confidence and make excellent progress.

The ELL programme offers academic support for children whose first language is not English.

- Support differs in terms of child's level: entry, emerging, intermediate, upper-intermediate
- 1:1 or small groups
- Tailored resources and personal goals
- Parents work closely with ELL team & teacher to develop the Individual Language Plan.
